- Attached are the Tournament Rules as well the Tie Breaker Chart – Please note the highest amount of emails that arrive on Saturday asking that we have the GF/GA calculations wrong.
- The simple fact is, we don't use that math equation. We have always used the % Ratio Chart
- (GOALS FOR DIVIDED BY / (GOALS FOR + GOALS AGAINST) HIGHER % TEAM ADVANCES.
- Coming soon will be the Scores Text to phone which also features once signed up, it tells you where you next game is what time what pad and who your opponent is.
- Tonight at 10PM the Final Version will be posted in the Event page Document section.

TEAM CHECK IN PROCEDURES Thursday or Friday:

- Headquarters will be open to accept teams and their official paperwork on Thursday April 14th from 4:00PM – 9:30PM
- Will reopen Friday & Saturday between 6:30am-11pm and Sunday from 8am-6pm
- All Teams will be required to have a min 4 Members to sign up for the Free Scores to phones – This system is super easy, we will send scores and advancement notices via text. Example, as soon as all Round Robin games are completed in your division and once we have ranked teams etc. you will; get on your phones – What time- What Arena- Which Pad – Who you are playing. This helps eliminate guests wondering where they play next etc. Details coming soon in an upcoming eblast broadcast

What do we need to bring to the Headquarters office to officially check my team in?

- All teams in the tournament must officially check in the teams either Thursday or Friday by 11PM. Failing to do so may result in forfeiture of games played Reference Rule# in the event
- We ask that only 1 Manager, Coach or Team Staff drop over to the Tournament Headquarters Office.
- All Ontario Teams are required bring their Official OWHA Roster for check in (No Waivers Accepted- Sample provided in Document Section)
- Don't have an Official OWHA Roster ? Please contact today your associations House OR Rep Director to obtain a copy if you do not have one in your possession
- All out of Province Teams: Will be required to produce a copy of your Official Provincial or USA Official Hockey Roster complete with player and team staff signatures.
- All out of province teams must also submit their Travel Permits Available to hand in a COPY at Headquarters if required by your Provincial Governing Body.
- REMINDER Players may only compete with 1 team and in 1 tournament this weekend
- **CALL-UP PLAYERS - ANY team using an OWHA Pickup Consent form MUST bring this to The Official Headquarters office before your first game, please note you cannot give this to an Arena convenor/ volunteer.**
- Failing to do so may result in forfeiture of games played as this is the only way for us to Secure your teams final roster in writing.
- If you are NOT Using any pickup consent forms then please feel free to arrive directly following your First Game to officially check into the tournament.
- When you check in the team, you will be issued what we call a Team Passport: We will review all your teams' paperwork for accuracy, deal with any Pickup Consent forms and then hand you a "TEAM PASSPORT".
- This document contains everything about your team for the weekend and how we can contact you if needed. You will be requested to carry this Passport document at all times in the event a discrepancy arises.
- We 'Sign off' after checking your paperwork on these documents you have provided so you do not have problems of proof you have checked in officially.
- What else are we getting this year when we do our FINAL Team Check in at Headquarters?
- We will be providing Complimentary Tournament Program BOOKS, chocolate and various other swag. (if you have a company that would like to donate any swag feel free to reach out to us).

STAFF & PLAYER SUSPENSIONS:

- It is each team's responsibility to report directly to the OWHA your suspensions and await their direction as to how many games are given. Reminder it is your requirement to write on the next game sheet the suspended individuals (Suspension 1 of ?) Whatever the OWHA directs you to comply

GAME SCORES & TOURNAMENT RESULTS:

- All SCORES/RESULTS will be posted ONLINE. ALL team managers and Head coaches are requested to sign up for the SCORES TEXT TO PHONE Feature, to allow you to be notified of advancements to next rounds as well watch all the games scores come to your phone.

- Scores Results BACK UP & CONTINGENCY PLAN: **In the event and for some reason the internet services go down we will release a backup site
- GAME SHEET ABENTS - If a member of your staff does not appear on the game sheet you may handwrite their information, providing proof to the convenor they are on the team roster
- GAME SHEET – CALL-UP PLAYERS please indicate on the game sheet in the first column using AP or CUP and show your 'team passport' to the convenor, to provide transparency the player has been approved at Headquarters
- GAME SHEET LABELS: Please also bring your own Games Sheet labels for all games after Round Robin Consolation-Elim - Qrts - Semi - Finals. You may also handwrite the roster on the game sheet if you have not printed lables
- GAME SHEET TEAM COPIES and ACCURACY – Timekeepers have been requested to drop your copy off at your dressing room. Please try to identify yourself. You may also be asked to INITIAL the final Score and Penalty Minutes to increase accuracy and resolve issues immediately before leaving the arena. If not delivered it will be found back at the game sheet sign in area. If game sheet is not delivered it will be found back at the game sheet sign in area.
- GAME SHEET WHITE COPIES – These are the official property of the OWHA. If you are accidentally given a white copy please, please ensure you do not take this copy as it is property of the OWHA and immediately return to the Arena Convenor.
- PLAYER OF GAME AWARDS: will be given to you when you sign the game-sheet table - these are for your team to award whenever you feel appropriate in your dressing room

HOUSE-LEAGUE & DS TEAMS JERSEY COLOR CONFLICTS:

- In an earlier email we allowed all teams to disclose colors to avoid conflicts- regardless its always best that all teams speak to your association to obtain a 2nd set of colored Jerseys or Pinnies this will help.

CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL:

- There will be NO ON ICE presentations or team photos. Reminder The champions will receive an Arena Banner as well as GOLD Medallions and the Finalist will receive Silver Medallions.
- Special Player of Game Awards will be provided for championship games

NEED SOME HELP. HAVE QUESTIONS ETC. WHO SHOULD WE ASK?

- Once onsite for the event, ask any of the *Canadettes Volunteers* at the game sheet table and or any Sportacular Event Staff, they will be wearing RED Jackets with the words EVENT STAFF across the back shoulders.
- DRESSING ROOM KEYS: You are required to come prepared with your own dressing room locks, where required
- DRESSING ROOMS: Everyone Appreciates A Clean Room - do your part to tidy up before vacating the room
- GAMES CAN START EARLY: a reminder, we can start UP to 20 Minutes before any scheduled game.
- Only Our arena Convenors and volunteers in coordination with both teams will discuss what their plans are.
- Always check at the game sheet sign in table...ONLY THEY WILL Determine if an early start is in effect.

EQUIPMENT RULE REMINDERS:

- ALL USA TEAMS –Mandatory Mouth guards are required as per your USA Hockey Insurance
- ALL CANADIAN TEAMS –Mandatory BNQ Neck guards are required as per Hockey Canada
